ORDER OF BUSINESS

The Municipal Election Commission meeting of April 15, 2025, having been duly publicized, was called to order by Chairperson Ben Watson at 10:01am in the Conference Room on the third floor of the Municipal Center.

Per Section 30-4-80(e) notice of the meeting was posted on the outside doors of the Municipal Center, the main bulletin board of the Municipal Center located on the first floor, and the City of North Augusta website.

Present were Chairperson Ben Watson and Commissioner Alpha Dunbar. Also in attendance was Jamie Paul, City Clerk; and Kevin Whaley, GIS Analyst.

ITEM 3. Approval of Minutes

a. March 11, 2025 meeting

The minutes of the Municipal Election Commission of March 11, 2025 were approved as submitted by general consent.

Clerk Paul confirmed that the polling location sign and the public notice were provided to Aiken County Registration and Elections to use on Election day. She explained to the MEC that the polling locations cannot be updated on the SCVotes.gov website for the City's General Election, however, they can find their precinct number and reference the public notice. She provided an example of the sample ballot for the election and stated that all precincts will be same. ITEM 8. Next meeting date(s)



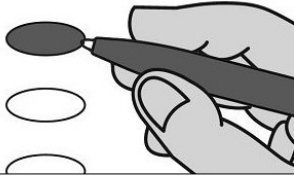
